SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to hunting, fishing, and trapping license fees; repealing and re-enacting Sec. 2(5), Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 2(5), Art. II, Ch. 94, SLA 1959 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(5) Resident hunting, trapping  
& sport fishing license . . . . . 15.00

Provided, however, that citizens of Alaska may hunt, fish, and trap without a license and be exempt from tag and seasonal personal consumption requirements if they meet or comply with the following conditions: (1) their annual gross earnings do not exceed \$1200.00; or (2) they are obtaining or have obtained during the immediately preceding six month, assistance under any state or federal welfare program to aid the indigent; or (3) they have historically been dependent on fish and game for subsistence; and (4) fish or game taken under this exemption, except for trapping, is not for resale.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
