IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION
A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to jurisdiction over juveniles; amending Sec. 19, Ch. 184, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 19, Ch. 184, SLA 1959 is amended by adding a new paragraph (9) to read:

(9) For cases involving minors under the age of eighteen years and arising under the provisions of Ch. 145, SLA 1957 as amended, when the minor is in a condition or surroundings dangerous or injurious to the welfare of the minor or others which requires immediate action, and such action by a district magistrate is not practicable because of time or distance. Any action by a deputy magistrate remains in effect only until a hearing regarding the custody of the minor is held by the district magistrate. Any action by the deputy magistrate is subject to the review of, and may at any time be rescinded by, the district magistrate.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
