SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION
A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the amount of funeral expenses that may be allowed under the Alaska Workmen's Compensation Act; amending Subsection (1) of Section 8, of Ch. 193, SLA 1959."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsection (1) of Sec. 8, Ch. 193, SLA 1959, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 8. Compensation for Death. If the injury causes death, the compensation shall be known as a death benefit and shall be payable in the amount and to or for the benefit of the persons following:

- (1) Reasonable and necessary funeral expenses not exceeding \$2000.00 [\$500.00].
