SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the salaries of teachers, principals, vice-principals, head teachers, teachers-in-charge and superintendents in schools in the State of Alaska; repealing and re-enacting Secs. 37-6-1, 37-6-2, and 37-6-3, ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-enacted by Ch. 179, SLA 1957; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 37-6-1, ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-enacted by Ch. 179, SLA 1957, is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 37-6-1. TEACHERS SALARY SCALE BY SENATE DISTRICT.

The school boards of school districts in the state and the state board of education, as the operating school board for schools outside school districts, shall pay regularly qualified teachers employed by them and with public school experience, allowable in accordance with the rules and regulations of the state board of education, a salary which shall be not less than that set forth in the following scale:

Southcentral Senate District

The amount of \$400 shall be added to each step of the Southeastern Senate District scale.

Central and Northwestern Senate Districts

and that portion of the Southcentral Senate District lying West of 152° West Longitude. The amount of \$700 shall be added to each step of the Southeastern Senate District scale.

Sec. 2. Sec. 37-6-2, ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-enacted by Ch. 179, SLA 1957, is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 37-6-2. SUPERINTENDENTS' SALARY SCALE BY SENATE DISTRICT. The school boards of school districts in the state and the state board of education, as the operating school board for schools outside school districts, shall pay regularly qualified superintendents employed by them the salary for which they qualify on the teachers' schedule plus the following differentials:

Superintendent of 85% to 100% schools . . .	\$ 1,200
Superintendent of 80% schools	1,800

2 Sec. 3. Sec. 37-6-3, ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-enacted
3 by Ch. 179, SLA 1957, is repealed and re-enacted to read:

4 Sec. 37-6-3. AMOUNTS ESTABLISHED ABOVE SALARY SCALE
5 FOR PRINCIPALS, VICE-PRINCIPALS, HEAD TEACHERS, AND TEACHERS-
6 IN-CHARGE. The school boards of school districts within the
7 state and the state board of education, as the operating
8 school board for schools outside school districts, shall pay
9 regularly qualified principals, vice-principals, head
10 teachers, and teachers-in-charge employed by them a salary
11 on the teachers' salary scale for the Senate District in
12 which employed, plus the following amounts in all districts:

13	Principals	\$ 800
14	Vice-principals	400
15	Head Teachers	400
16	Teachers-in-Charge	200

17 Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
18 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
