SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating refunds of the proceeds of the coin operated device tax to municipalities; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The sum of \$38,648.00 is appropriated from the general fund to the following municipalities in the listed amounts as refunds of a portion of the coin operated devices tax earned within such municipalities according to the provisions of Sec. 48-3-6, ACLA 1949 as repealed and re-enacted by Sec. 6, Ch. 142, SLA 1960:
