SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act regarding the support of schools
in newly incorporated first or second
class cities; amending Ch. 90, SLA 1960;
and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Ch. 90, SLA 1960, is amended to read:

Sec. 1. Notwithstanding any other provisions of law,
in the event that any previously unincorporated area or city
of the fourth class served by a totally state supported school
or schools voluntarily incorporates as a city of the first or
second class [OR AS AN INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT], the res-
ponsibility of the state for the continued support of the
local schools in the newly incorporated area shall be as
follows:

(1) For the first fiscal year of operation begin-
ning on July 1 following the incorporation, the state shall
pay from appropriations available for support of [DISTRICT]
schools outside incorporated districts, 100% of the [DIS-
TRICT] budget approved by the commissioner of education
pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 37-3-63, ACLA 1949 as
amended or as hereafter amended. Local expenditures above
the level of the approved budget may be made by the local
school board, but shall be paid for with local funds;

(2) For the second fiscal year of operation, the

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state shall pay from appropriations available for the support of [DISTRICT] schools outside incorporated districts, 90% of the [DISTRICT] budget approved by the commissioner of education pursuant to the provisions of Sec. 37-3-63, ACLA 1949 as amended or as hereafter amended. Local expenditures above the level of the approved budget may be made by the local school board, but shall be paid for with local funds;

(3) For the third fiscal year of operation, and for each and every fiscal year thereafter, the city school district [OR INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT] shall be placed in the appropriate school district reimbursement category in accordance with then existing state laws.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the first day of July, 1961.
