5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the monetary allowance
7 for guests of the Alaska Pioneers' Home;
8 amending Sec. 51-2-13, ACLA 1949, as last
9 amended by Ch. 118, SLA 1957; and providing
10 for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 51-2-13, ACLA 1949, as last amended by Ch.
13 118, SLA 1957, is amended to read:

14 Sec. 51-2-13. PERSONS ENTITLED TO BE ADMITTED TO HOME.

15 Every worthy person residing in Alaska, and who shall have
16 been a resident of Alaska [THE TERRITORY] continuously for
17 more than fifteen [FIVE] years immediately preceding his
18 application for admission, and who shall be destitute and in
19 need of the aid or benefit of said Home in consequence of
20 physical disability or other cause, shall be entitled to
21 admission thereto subject to the conditions, limitations
22 and penalties prescribed by the rules and regulations of the
23 superintendent [BOARD]. But no person shall be admitted as
24 an inmate to the Alaska Pioneers' Home under the provisions
25 of this Act, where the support and maintenance of such person
26 is imposed by law upon any relative or member of the family
27 of such person.

28 Every person heretofore or hereafter admitted to the
29 Pioneers' Home, except persons admitted under Section 51-2-14,

1 ACLA 1949, who receives income from any source whatsoever in
2 excess of \$20.00 [FIFTEEN (\$15.00) DOLLARS] per month may
3 be required [BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES] to pay such excess
4 to the Superintendent of said Home immediately upon receipt
5 thereof in payment, or part payment, of the cost of his
6 maintenance.

7 At the end of each month said Superintendent shall
8 transmit all such payments to the State [TERRITORIAL]
9 Department of Revenue [TREASURER] together with the names
10 of the persons making same and the amount paid by each.
11 Provided, that the Superintendent [BOARD OF TRUSTEES] is
12 hereby directed [AUTHORIZED] to pay the sum of \$20.00
13 [TEN (\$10.00) DOLLARS] per month to any resident without
14 funds.

15 All moneys thus received shall be covered into the
16 General Fund.

17 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
18 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
