6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend the Village Incorporation
7 Act of 1957; amending Sec. 6, Ch. 150, SLA
8 1957 as amended by Sec. 1, Ch. 79, SLA 1959;
9 and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 6(4), Ch. 150, SLA 1957 is amended to read:

12 (4) To levy and collect a sales tax not to exceed
13 three [TWO] percent in accordance with the procedure set
14 forth in Sec. 7 of this Act, and to prescribe the manner of
15 collecting said taxes.

16 Sec. 2. Sec. 6(12), Ch. 150, SLA 1957 as added by Sec. 1,
17 Ch. 79, SLA 1959 is amended to read:

18 (12) OFFENSES: DISPOSITION OF MONEY FROM FINES: MAGIS-
19 TRATE. To prohibit drunkenness, gambling, houses or places
20 of ill fame, disorderly conduct, or conduct endangering the
21 public peace, public health, or public safety, and define
22 such offenses, and to prescribe the punishment therefor, but
23 such punishment shall not exceed in any case a fine of
24 \$50.00 [\$25.00] or imprisonment in the village jail not ex-
25 ceeding five days, which may be set aside if the payment of
26 \$5.00 per day is made in lieu thereof, or both such fine and
27 imprisonment. All fines and costs imposed and collected for
28 violation of village ordinances shall belong to the village
29 and be paid over to the proper village officer. The village

magistrate shall have jurisdiction of all actions for viola-
tions of village ordinances, and appeals shall lie from his
judgment to the United States District Court for the Division
in which such village is situate, in the same manner as
appeals from the judgment of the ex-officio justices of the
peace to the District Court. Proceedings before the village
magistrate shall be in substantial conformity with those
proceedings generally held in a magistrate's court of a
second class city.

Sec. 3. Sec. 6, Ch. 150, SLA 1957 as last amended by Sec. 1,
Ch. 79, SLA 1959 is amended to add a new Subsec. (18) to read:

(18) To provide for the terms of councilmen.

Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
