BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Paragraph First, Sec. 55-9-78, ACLA 1949, as

13

last amended by Sec. 1, Ch. 65, SLA 1957, is amended to read:

First. The earnings of the judgment debtor, for his

15

personal services rendered at any time within thirty days

16

next preceding the levy of execution or attachment, to the

17

amount of Three Hundred Fifty Dollars when he is the head of

18

a family and the amount of Two Hundred Dollars in the event

19

he is a single man and when it appears by the debtor's

20

affidavit or otherwise that such earnings are necessary for

21

his use or for the use of his family, supported in whole or

22

in part by his labor; provided, that any money received on

23

account on earnings during the thirty-day period hereinabove

24

mentioned and prior to the levy of the execution or attach-

25

ment, shall be charged against the exemption herein mentioned,

26

and the amount of exemption shall be reduced accordingly; it

27

being the intention of the Act to provide an exemption to the

28

wage earner of not to exceed Three Hundred Fifty Dollars when

29

the wage earner is the head of a family or not to exceed

Two Hundred Dollars in the event he is a single man in every  
thirty-day period prior to the levy of attachment or execu-  
tion.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
