SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to jury trials in magistrate courts; amending Ch. 184, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Ch. 184, SLA 1959, is amended by adding a new Sec. 10A to read:

Sec. 10A. JURY TRIALS. The trial jury in the magistrate courts shall consist of a body of persons six in number.

Sec. 2. This Act shall not affect any proceedings commenced before the effective date of this Act.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect June 1, 1961.
