5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the completion and
7 publication of the records of the Alaska
8 Constitutional Convention of 1955-1956;
9 authorizing an appropriation; and providing
10 for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. It is the intent of the Legislature that the
13 records of the proceedings of the Alaska Constitutional Convention,
14 1955-1956, be completed and published in permanent form because of
15 their legal, historical and research value to the state.

16 Sec. 2. The secretary of state serving as the director of
17 archives for the state, is assigned the duty of accomplishing the
18 completing, editing, indexing, duplicating and distributing of a
19 compilation of the daily journals, minutes, committee reports, and
20 other materials incidental to the work and deliberations of the
21 convention. The secretary of state is authorized to integrate and
22 arrange logically all relevant records and materials of the con-
23 vention. The resulting compilation will be certified by the
24 president and secretary of the convention, or, in the event of
25 their inability to so act for any reason, by the secretary of state.

26 Sec. 3. The form and style of the publication of the records
27 of the convention shall be determined by the secretary of state
28 with the advice and assistance of the attorney general, a repre-
29 sentative of the chief justice of the supreme court, and the

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1 executive director of the legislative council. The convention
2 records shall be published in sufficient quantity to meet the
3 official needs of the court, legal, research, and public libraries
4 of the state. Copies available for sale to individuals and
5 organizations may be sold at a price determined by the secretary
6 to help defray production costs.

7 Sec. 4. An appropriation in an amount not to exceed
8 \$10,000.00 is authorized to cover the necessary contractual and
9 other expenses necessary to carry out the purposes of this Act.
10 The appropriation may be made to the Office of the Governor and
11 be included in the general appropriation bill.

12 Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
13 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
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
