6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the regulation of civil
7 aeronautics in Alaska; amending Sec. 8, Ch.
8 161, SLA 1960; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 8, Ch. 161, SLA 1960 is amended to read as
12 follows:

13 Sec. 8. TEMPORARY EXEMPTION OF AIR CARRIERS. From
14 time to time when an emergency requires, the commission may
15 exempt from the requirements of this Act or any provision
16 thereof, or any rule, regulation, term, condition, or limi-
17 tation prescribed thereunder, any air carrier or class of
18 air carriers, if the commission finds that the enforcement
19 of this Act or such provision, or such rule, regulation,
20 term, condition or limitation is or would be an undue burden
21 on such air carrier or class of air carriers by reason of
22 the emergency, or unusual circumstances affecting the opera-
23 tion of such air carrier or class of air carriers, and is
24 not in the public interest. The commission shall issue any
25 regulation or order for a temporary exemption pursuant to
26 the provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act; provided
27 that an order need not be of general applicability and pro-
28 vided that a finding of emergency as required by Sec. 2 (2),
29 Art. IV, Ch. 1, Ch. 143, SLA 1959 need not be first made as

a condition to issuing an emergency regulation or order.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
