6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the form of ballots in
7 state elections; amending Secs. 3.03 and
8 5.06, Ch. 83, SLA 1960."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Sec. 3.03 (5), Ch. 83, SLA 1960, is repealed and
11 re-enacted to read:

12 (5) The general election ballot shall be printed
13 on white paper with the names of each candidate and their
14 party designations placed in separate sections under the
15 office designation to which they were nominated. The party
16 affiliation, if any, shall be designated after the name of
17 the candidate. The secretary of state and governor shall be
18 included under the same section. Provision shall be made
19 for voting for write-in and no-party candidates within each
20 section.

21 Sec. 2. Sec. 5.06, Ch. 83, SLA 1960, is repealed and re-
22 enacted to read:

23 Sec. 5.06. PREPARATION AND DISTRIBUTION OF BALLOTS.
24 The primary nomination ballot shall be prepared and distri-
25 buted by the secretary of state in the manner prescribed
26 for general election ballots, except as specifically provided
27 otherwise for the primary nomination. The secretary of
28 state shall place the names of all candidates who have
29 properly filed and their party designation in separate sec-

tions under the office designations to which they seek nomi-
nation. The party affiliation, if any, shall be designated
after the name of the candidate. Within each office the
name of each candidate shall be rotated as provided for the
general election ballot.
