IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to coin-operated devices; amending Sec. 43-3-8, ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-enacted by Ch.142, SLA 1960; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 48-3-8, ACLA 1949, as repealed and re-enacted by Sec. 8, Ch. 142, SLA 1960, is amended to read:

Sec. 48-3-8. GAMBLING NOT LEGALIZED. This Act shall not be construed in any way to legalize gambling or the possession of any gambling device. Coin-operated devices on which the required tax stamp has been paid shall not be subject to seizure unless they contain reels with symbols thereon or automatic facilities for releasing coins, tokens, merchandise or similar objects.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
