6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to employment for certain
7 tax exempt organizations in the Alaska Em-
8 ployment Security Act; amending Sec. 222, Art.
9 II, Ch. 5, ESLA 1955; and providing for an
10 effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 222, Art. II, Ch. 5, ESLA 1955 is amended to
13 read:

14 Section 222. The term "employment" shall not include
15 service performed by an individual in any calendar quarter
16 after December 31, 1960 [1954], in the employ of any organiza-
17 tion exempt from income tax under Section 501(a) of the
18 Federal Internal Revenue Code, other than an organization des-
19 cribed in Section 401(a) or [OF] Section 521 thereof, if (a)
20 the remuneration for such service is less than \$250.00 [\$50];
21 or (b) such service is in connection with the collection of
22 dues or premiums for a fraternal beneficiary society, order,
23 or association, and is performed away from the home office, or
24 is ritualistic service in connection with any such society,
25 order, or association; or (c) such service is performed by a
26 student who is enrolled and is regularly attending classes, at
27 a school, college, or university; or (d) such service is per-
28 formed by a duly ordained, commissioned, or licensed minister
29 of religion in the exercise of his ministry, or by a member of

1 a religious order in the exercise of duties required by such
2 order.

3 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
4 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
