A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the consent of the state to be sued; amending Ch. 170, SLA 1957..

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 1, Ch. 170, SLA 1957 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Section 1. The State of Alaska hereby consents that an action may be maintained against it for any act or omission, whether governmental or proprietary, to the same extent as against a private individual.

Sec. 2. Sec. 7, Ch. 170, SLA 1957 is repealed.
