HOUSE BILL NO. 196

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to liability to employees for defects or insufficiency of machinery; amending Sec. 43-2-51, ACLA 1949."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 43-2-51, ACLA 1949 is amended to read:

Sec. 43-2-51. LIABILITY TO EMPLOYEES FOR DEFECTS OR INSUFFICIENCY OF MACHINERY. Every person, association, or corporation engaged in the business of manufacturing, mining, constructing, building or other hazardous business or occupation carried on by means of machinery or mechanical appliances, or any other inherently dangerous equipment, shall be liable to any of its employees, or, in the event of his death, to his personal representative for the benefit of his widow and children, if any, if none, then for his parents, if none, then for his next of kin dependent upon him, for all damages which may result from the negligence of any of its or his or their officers, agents, or employees, or by reason of any defect or insufficiency due to its or their negligence in the machinery, appliances and works.
