HOUSE BILL NO. 220

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA  
SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the posting of rates in places of public lodging."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Every owner or keeper of any hotel, inn, motel, or motor court in this state shall post, in a conspicuous place in the office or lobby, and in every bedroom of such establishment, a printed copy of a statement of the rate of charges by the day for lodging. The rates posted in the office or lobby, and every bedroom of the establishment shall display the daily rate of such room for occupancy by one person, for occupancy by two persons, the additional charge for each person over two persons, or the additional charge for each additional bed provided in the room. No establishment shall charge more for the accommodations than the posted rates.

Sec. 2. Any owner or keeper of any hotel, inn, motel, or motor court who violates this Act is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$250.00, or by imprisonment for not more than 10 days, or by both the fine and imprisonment.
