SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to physicians acting under emergency circumstances; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Any physician, licensed in this state or any other state, who ^{voluntarily} attempts to aid an injured party ^{person} in need of medical care, ^{under such} while under no legal duty to render aid, and under ^{emergency} circumstances that suggest that the giving of aid is the only alternative to death or serious bodily injury, is ~~not~~ ^{only} liable for ~~negligent acts~~ ^{wilful wrongs} committed in rendering the aid. This Act does not diminish the liability of a physician for wilful wrongs done to injured parties.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
