6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to insurance and amending

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 Section 1. Sec. 42-1-27, ACLA 1949 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 42-1-27. BENEFICIARIES: INUREMENT OF BENEFITS TO.
11 In case any life insurance company, fraternal order or bene-
12 ficiary society shall have issued or shall hereafter issue
13 any policy or policies of insurance, including annuities and
14 credit life insurance, or beneficiary certificate upon the life
15 of an individual and payable at the death of the assured, or
16 in any given number of years, to any person or persons having
17 an insurable interest in the life of the assured; or in case
18 any accident and health insurance company shall have issued
19 or shall hereafter issue any policy or policies of insurance,
20 including credit accident and health insurance; [,] all such
21 policies and their reserves of the present and cash value
22 thereof and death or other benefits including annuity payments
23 shall inure to the sole and separate use and benefit of the
24 beneficiaries named therein, and shall be free from the claims
25 of the assured, and shall also be free from the claims of the
26 person or persons effecting such insurance, their creditors
27 and representatives, and shall be free from all taxes and
28 claims and judgments of the creditors and representatives of
29 the person or persons named in said policy or policies of

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insurance, including the owner, assured, insured and bene-
ficiaries. This section shall not apply if, prior to the
payment of the proceeds from the insurance, the insurance
company has received a written claim from a creditor of the
assured for the premiums, or portion of premiums, paid for
an insurance policy with the intent to defraud creditors.
