SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the suspension of drivers licenses pending deposit of security to satisfy possible judgments; amending Secs. 8 and 11, Ch. 163, SLA 1959; repealing and re-enacting Paragraph (6), Sec. 8, Ch. 163, SLA 1959."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Paragraph (6), Sec. 8, Ch. 163, SLA 1959, is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(6) To the driver or owner of a vehicle which at the time of the accident was parked, unless the vehicle was parked negligently or in violation of a law or ordinance intended to promote safety.

Sec. 2. Sec. 8, Ch. 163, SLA 1959, is amended by the addition of a paragraph (10) to read:

(10) To the driver of a vehicle which is struck in the rear while stopped in compliance with a traffic sign or signal.

Sec. 3. Paragraph (1), Sec. 11, Ch. 163, SLA 1959, is amended to read:

(1) The license of any driver or drivers who are at fault in an accident and who have been required to deposit security and have not deposited the required amount;

[EACH DRIVER IN ANY MANNER INVOLVED IN THE ACCIDENT;]
