6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the transfer to first
7 class cities of state lands within the bound-
8 aries of cities; amending Art. III, Ch. 169,
9 SLA 1959 as amended by Chs. 61 and 155, SLA
10 1960; and providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Art. III, Ch. 169, SLA 1959 as amended by Chs. 61
13 and 155, SLA 1960 is amended to add a new Sec. 12 to read:

14 Sec. 12. STATE LANDS TO BE TRANSFERRED TO CITIES. Any
15 city of the first class may apply in the manner prescribed by
16 the director, within three years from the effective date of
17 this Act, for a conveyance to the city of all surplus state
18 lands located within the boundaries of the city. Surplus
19 state lands mean all land owned by the state which are not
20 presently used or for which there is no anticipated immediate
21 use by the state. The director shall promulgate reasonable
22 regulations designating surplus state lands within cities and
23 governing the filing and processing of applications and the
24 execution of the conveyance to assure the prompt, orderly and
25 simple transfer of title from the state to the cities within
26 three years of the effective date of this Act. Upon receipt
27 of an application properly filed, the director shall convey
28 the state lands to the city.

29 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage

1 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
