For an Act entitled: "Providing for waiver of coverage by execu-
7 tive officers, amending Subsection 8 of
8 Section 2, Chapter 193, SLA 1959."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Subsection 8 of Section 2, Chapter 193, SLA 1959,
11 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(8) Wherever the term "employer" is used in this Act, refer-
ence is had to the State or any of its political subdivisions and
to any person or persons, partnerships, joint stock company,
association or corporation employing one or more persons in con-
nection with any business or industry coming within the scope
hereof and carried on in this State, and whenever the term "em-
ployee" is used herein, reference is had to an employee employed
by an employer as above defined.

Every executive officer elected or appointed and empowered
in accordance with the charter and by-laws of a corporation, other
than an official of a municipal corporation or a charitable, re-
ligious, educational or other non-profit corporation, shall be an
employee of such corporation under this Act. Provided, however,
that any executive officer of a corporation may waive coverage
under this Act, subject to the approval of the Commissioner of
Labor, notwithstanding provisions of Section 14 (2). Notwith-
standing any other provision of this Act, any such executive
officer of a municipal corporation or of a charitable, religious,

1 educational, or any other non-profit corporation may be brought
2 within the coverage of its insurance contract by any such corp-
3 oration by specifically including such executive officer in such
4 contract of insurance and the election to bring such executive
5 officer within the coverage shall continue for the period such
6 contract of insurance is in effect, and during such period such
7 executive officers thus brought within the coverage of the in-
8 surance contract shall be employees of such corporation under this
9 Act.
