6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to establish a uniform time for the  
7 State of Alaska; and providing for an  
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. UNIFORM TIME. For the purpose of establishing a  
11 single uniform time for the State of Alaska, the entire state  
12 shall be one time zone, the time in which shall be the same as  
13 United States Standard Pacific Time (Pacific Standard Time) as  
14 established and described by federal statute, 15 USC 261 and 263.

15 Sec. 2. DUTY TO OBSERVE UNIFORM TIME. In all statutes,  
16 orders, rules, and regulations relating to the time of performance  
17 of any act by any officer, employee or department of the state or  
18 of its political subdivisions, whether in the legislative, execu-  
19 tive, or judicial branches of the government, or relating to the  
20 time within which any rights shall accrue or determine, or within  
21 which any act shall or may not be performed by any person subject  
22 to the jurisdiction of the state, it shall be understood and  
23 intended that the time shall be the uniform time for the State of  
24 Alaska established by this Act.

25 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect at 2:00  
26 o'clock antemeridian United States Standard Pacific Time (Pacific  
27 Standard Time) on 28 May 1961 and shall terminate on 3 September  
28 1961 at the same hour, it being the intent of the legislature to  
29 try out the effectiveness and desirability of the principle
