6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the citizenship of state  
7 employees; amending Sec. 11-1-4, ACLA 1949, as  
8 last amended by Ch. 74, SLA 1959; and pro-  
9 viding for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 11-1-4, ACLA 1949, as last amended by Ch. 74,  
12 SLA 1959, is amended to read:

13 Sec. 11-1-4. EMPLOYMENT OF PERSONS NOT CITIZENS PRO-  
14 HIBITED. It shall be unlawful for the State of Alaska, or  
15 any municipality in the State to employ at any rate of com-  
16 pensation as officer, agent, or servant, any person who is  
17 not a citizen of the United States, except that the provisions  
18 of this Act shall not apply to doctors, dentists, public  
19 health nurses, and technicians employed by the Alaska Depart-  
20 ment of Health, or to biologists or other technicians employed  
21 by the Alaska Department of Fish and Game, provided, however,  
22 that such persons shall have filed their declaration of in-  
23 tention, and shall actively pursue such application for  
24 citizenship, and shall have, before employment, taken and  
25 submitted to the oath provided for in Chapter 113, SLA 1949  
26 known as the non-Communist oath, and provided further than in  
27 no event shall this Act apply to teachers, librarians or other  
28 professional persons employed on an emergency basis or  
29 temporarily employed or retained under a foreign exchange
