HOUSE BILL NO. 265

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the payment of a reward for reporting a violation of commercial fishing laws and regulations; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. A reward of \$100.00 shall be paid to any person, other than a peace officer, who reports information that leads to the conviction of any person who has violated the laws of the state or regulations of the board of fish and game pertaining to commercial fishing. Upon conviction, the attorney general shall certify the eligibility of the person claiming the reward, and the reward shall be paid by the commissioner of revenue from unobligated funds in the state general fund.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
