SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Fish & Game Code;
amending Sec. 11, Art. III, Ch. 94, SLA 1959."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 11, Art. III, Ch. 94, SLA 1959 is amended
to read as follows:

Sec. 11. LICENSE FORFEITURE. Upon both first and
second convictions of a person for a violation of any
provision of this Article or of any Federal or State law
or regulation for the protection of the commercial fish of
Alaska, the Court may, in addition to the penalty imposed
by law, forfeit the commercial fishing license of such person
for a period of one year. Upon a third conviction of any
such person of any such violation, the forfeiture of such
license for a period of not more than three years shall be
mandatory. Any forfeiture under this section is effective
immediately upon conviction and no stay pending appeal may
be granted.
