6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Fish & Game Code;
7 amending Sec. 11, Art. III, Ch. 94, SLA 1959;
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. Sec. 11, Art. III, Ch. 94, SLA 1959 is amended
11 to read as follows:

12 Sec. 11. LICENSE FORFEITURE. Upon both first and
13 second convictions of a person for a violation of any
14 provision of this Article or of any Federal or State law
15 or regulation for the protection of the commercial fish of
16 Alaska, the Court may, in addition to the penalty imposed
17 by law, forfeit the commercial fishing license of such person
18 for a period of one year. Upon a third conviction of any
19 such person of any such violation, the forfeiture of such
20 license for a period of not more than three years shall be
21 mandatory. Any forfeiture under this section is effective
22 immediately upon conviction and no stay pending appeal may
23 be granted.

24 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
25 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
