6 For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating refunds of the pro-
7 ceeds of the tax on non-profit electric and
8 telephone membership cooperatives to muni-
9 cipalities, independent school districts and
10 public utility districts; and providing for
11 an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 Section 1. The sum of \$94,517 is appropriated from the
14 general fund to the following municipalities, independent school
15 districts and public utility districts in the listed amounts as
16 refunds of the portion of the tax on non-profit electric and tele-
17 phone membership cooperatives earned within such jurisdictions
18 according to the provisions of Sec. 33, Ch. 93, SLA 1959.
