HOUSE BILL NO. 269

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to bounties; amending Sec. 33-3-119, ACLA 1949; amending Sec. 33-3-131 as last amended by Ch. 162, SLA 1960; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 33-3-119, ACLA 1949 is amended to read:

Sec. 33-3-119. BOUNTY NOT TO BE PAID [EMPLOYEES]. No bounty shall be paid under this Act to any person who is not a resident of the state or to any salaried employee of any federal or state agency which is engaged in fish or game protection, management or research activity. For the purposes of this section, "resident" means a person who for the immediately preceding year has maintained a permanent place of abode within the state and who has continually maintained his legal residence in the state [ON ANY WOLF OR COYOTE KILLED BY ANY SALARIED EMPLOYEE OF THE ALASKA GAME COMMISSION, THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE AND THE FOREST SERVICE].

Sec. 2. Sec. 33-3-131, ACLA 1949 as last amended by Sec. 1, Ch. 162, SLA 1960 is amended to read:

Sec. 33-3-131. BOUNTY ON HAIR SEAL DECLARED. a. There is hereby placed on every hair seal inhabiting the inland waters and all water adjacent to the southern coast of Alaska east of the 152nd Meridian, and the waters of Bristol Bay and the coastal waters within three miles off the Mainland from

1 Cape Newenham to Cape Kruzenstern, inclusive, a bounty of
2 \$3.00, such sum to be paid in accordance with the provisions
3 following.

4 b. No bounty shall be paid on any hair seal killed
5 by any person who is not a resident of the state or to any
6 salaried employee of any federal or state agency which is en-
7 gaged in fish or game protection, management or research
8 activity. For the purposes of this section, "resident" means
9 a person who for the immediately preceding year has maintained
10 a permanent abode within the state and who has continually
11 maintained his legal residence in the state.
