5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Board of Hairdressers
7 and Beauty Culture Examiners."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 Section 1. Subsec. (1) of Sec. 4, Ch. 52, SLA 1957
10 is amended to read as follows:

11 (1) Requirements for licenses.

12 (A) No person shall be eligible for a license as
13 an operator, [MANAGER-OPERATOR,] demonstrator or consultant,
14 or owner-operator, [OR INSTRUCTOR-OPERATOR,] unless:

15 (a) He shall have attained the age of 17 years.

16 (b) He is of good moral character.

17 (c) He has completed two years of high school
18 or its equivalent.

19 (d) He has pursued a course of instruction
20 in a licensed school of hairdressing or beauty culture
21 [ANY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

22 1. TRAINING] of at least 2,000 hours,
23 extending over a school term of not less than 50 weeks
24 of not more than 40 hours a week, in a school of hair-
25 dressing and/or beauty culture approved by the Board.

26 [2. SERVICE AS AN APPRENTICE UNDER A
27 LICENSED OPERATOR IN A SHOP APPROVED BY THE BOARD.]

28 (B) No person shall be eligible for license as a
29 manager-operator unless:

1 (a) He has passed an examination and holds an
2 operator or owner-operator license.

3 (b) He has engaged in the practice of hairdressing
4 or beauty culture for one year prior to application
5 under a manager-operator or owner-operator.

6 (c) No person shall be eligible for license as an
7 instructor-operator unless:

8 (a) He has completed four years of high school or
9 its equivalent.

10 (b) He has met the requirements of a manager-
11 operator.

12 (c) He has passed an examination and holds a
13 manager-operator license.

14 Sec. 2. Subsec. (4) of Sec. 4, Ch. 52, SLA 1957 is amended
15 to read as follows:

16 (4) Admission without examination. A person who
17 has been examined and issued a license by a board of cosme-
18 tology in any state, territory, or the District of Columbia
19 whose requirements for operator training are 2,000 hours or
20 more or who has had one year shop experience prior to appli-
21 cation for reciprocity may be licensed in Alaska without
22 examination upon payment of the proper fee.

23 (a) Upon furnishing proof satisfactory to the
24 Board that he holds such foreign license and that
25 it is in effect upon the date of his application; and

26 (b) Upon meeting such other requirements as
27 may be established by the Board.

28 Shop owners may be licensed without examination,
29 but unless otherwise qualified as an operator under this Act,

1 shall not engage in the practice of hairdressing and/or
2 beauty culture, but shall employ a licensed manager-operator.

8 Sec. 3. Sec. 3(2)(c) is amended to read as follows:

4 (c) The Board shall have the power to suspend or
5 revoke any license pursuant to the Administrative Procedure
6 Act. [THIS ACT, SUBJECT, HOWEVER, TO THE PROVISION FOR
7 HEARINGS, AS HEREINAFTER SET FORTH.]

8 Sec. 4. Subsec. (12) of Sec. 1, Sec. 10, and Sec. 14,
9 Ch. 52, SLA 1957 are repealed.
