For an Act entitled: "An Act making certain appropriations; and
7 providing an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9

Section 1. The sum of \$752.25 is appropriated from the
10 general fund to reimburse the Daily Alaska Empire for expenses
11 incurred by the state prior to January 1, 1959.

Sec. 2. The sum of \$142.20 is appropriated from the general
fund to the Legislative Council to reimburse Ellis Airlines for
travel expenses incurred by the state during the biennium ending
June 30, 1959.

Sec. 3. The sum of \$99,135 is appropriated out of the
Cigarette Tax Fund to the Department of Education for the rehabil-
itation, construction and major repair of rural school buildings.

Sec. 4. The sum of \$638.00 is appropriated from the general
fund to the Department of Education to reimburse The Fairbanks
Independent School District for expenses incurred for vocational
education pursuant to an agreement with the state during the
fiscal year ending June 30, 1960.

Sec. 5. The sum of \$66.33 is appropriated from the general
fund to the Board of Nursing to pay expenses of the board for the
fiscal year ending June 30, 1959.

Sec. 6. The sum of \$37,000 is appropriated from the general
fund to the line item for equipment, Protection Division, Depart-
ment of Fish and Game.

1 Sec. 7. The sum of \$700.00 is appropriated from the general
2 fund to reimburse the estate of Donald J. O'Connor for services
3 performed in connection with freight hearings on behalf of the
4 state.

5 Sec. 8. The sum of \$12.95 is appropriated from the general
6 fund to pay Hopson's Cafe, Barrow, Alaska for meals furnished on
7 June 6, 1958 to a Territorial Officer and prisoners.

8 Sec. 9. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
9 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
