6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to refunds of retail
7 license fees to establishments having
8 gross sales of less than \$20,000.00 in
9 the license year; amending Sec. 35-4-21(G),
10 ACLA 1949, as last amended by Sec. 2,
11 Ch. 197, SLA 1959; and providing for an
12 effective date."

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

14 Section 1. Sec. 35-4-21(G), ACLA 1949, as amended by
15 Ch. 114, SLA 1953, as amended by Sec. 2, Ch. 131, SLA 1957, as
16 amended by Sec. 2, Ch. 197, SLA 1959, is amended to read as
17 follows:

18 (G) A Retail License shall give to the holder thereof
19 the right to sell for cash in his establishment intoxicating
20 liquors, including beer and wine, in the original packages
21 and wine in bulk. All liquor requiring Internal Revenue
22 strip stamps shall have such stamps intact upon the packages.
23 The consumption of any intoxicating liquor on premises
24 licensed under this provision is prohibited. Sales under
25 a Retail License shall be limited to less than five wine
26 gallons to any one person in any one sale. The Retail
27 License Fee shall be Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00), provided,
28 however, that any retail liquor store which shall have gross
29 sales amounting to less than Twenty Thousand Dollars

(\$20,000.00) in any calendar year from the sale of intoxicating liquors, including beer and wine, the licensee holding the license at the end of the calendar year shall be refunded Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) [THE RETAIL LICENSE FEE SHALL BE THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$300.00).]

Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
