6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to bank examination
7 fees; amending Sec. 2.107, Art. II,
8 Ch. 129, SLA 1951; and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 2.107, Art. II, Ch. 129, SLA 1951 is
12 amended to read:

13 SECTION 2.107 EXAMINATION [EXAMINER'S] FEES

14 The commissioner shall set a fee not to exceed \$100.00
15 which shall be charged for each day such person shall spend
16 examining such bank; [SUCH PERSON SO EXAMINING SUCH BANK
17 SHALL BE PAID THEREFOR A REASONABLE FEE FIXED BY THE BOARD
18 WHICH SHALL NOT EXCEED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$50.00) PER DAY;]
19 provided, that any bank, the deposits of which are insured by
20 the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation or any agency of
21 the United States which insures bank deposits, in whole or in
22 part, may, in the discretion of the commissioner [BOARD], be
23 relieved of such examinations, and of the fees thereby
24 incurred. Out of this fee the commissioner shall pay the
25 fee of the examiner, not to exceed \$50.00 per day and the
26 costs of transportation of the examiner within the state
27 and the per-diem expenses of the examiner, not to exceed the
28 rates currently allowed for state employees. The amount of
29 the fee [TO WHICH AN EXAMINER SHALL BE ENTITLED] shall be

paid by the bank so examined to the commissioner [BOARD]
immediately upon the bank being advised of the amount thereof.
Section 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its
passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such
approval.
