HOUSE BILL NO. 289

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act abolishing the Department of Public Safety and transferring its functions and authority to the Department of Law; amending Secs. 9 and 18, Ch. 64, SLA 1959."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 9, Ch. 64, SLA 1959 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

Effective July 1, 1962, the functions performed and authority exercised by the Department of Public Safety are transferred to the Department of Law.

Sec. 2. Sec. 18, Ch. 64, SLA 1959 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

Effective July 1, 1962, the Department of Public Safety is abolished and its functions and authority transferred to the Department of Law.

Sec. 3. The Department of Law may, within 30 days after July 1, 1962, adopt Department of Public Safety regulations by transmitting them to the secretary of state for filing, without complying with notice and hearing provisions of the Administrative Procedure Act. No substantive change may be made in regulations adopted under this section. Department of Public Safety regulations continue in effect 30 days after July 1, 1962, unless sooner adopted or repealed by the Department of Law.
