HOUSE BILL NO. 327

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the re-employment and seniority rights of reservists called to active military service; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 2, Ch. 20, SLA 1951 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Section 2. A member of any reserve component of the armed forces of the United States employed by the State of Alaska or its political subdivisions and called to active duty, shall be entitled to re-employment with accrued seniority in the same position held by him when ordered to duty if he applies for reinstatement within 90 days of his honorable discharge from military service.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
