6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Governor's Advisory
7 Committee on Economic Development in the
8 office of the governor; amending Sec. 7,
9 Ch. 64, SLA 1959, and providing for an
10 effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 7, Ch. 64, SLA 1959, is amended by adding
13 a paragraph to read:

14 N There is hereby established the Governor's Advisory
15 E Committee on Economic Development in the office of the
16 W governor consisting of 44 members appointed for overlapping
17 four-year terms. Initial appointments of committee
18 members shall be as follows: 11 members shall be appointed
19 for one year, 11 members for two years, 11 members for
20 three years, and 11 members for four years. The provisions
21 of Sec. 6, Ch. 64, SLA 1959 apply to the committee except
22 that members shall not be compensated for their services
23 by payment of salary or per diem, nor be reimbursed for
24 M travel expenses or any other expenses. Committee members
25 A shall be appointed from various economic interests and
26 T from the several regions of the state. The committee is
27 T authorized to study state, regional and local economic
28 E problems and formulate recommendations for review by the
29 R office of the governor. It may publicize its purposes and

1 N objectives, conduct surveys and studies relating to economic
2 E problems of the state, and accept services of personnel
3 W of public and private agencies in gathering information.
4 The committee may accept gifts and grants from the federal
5 government, state government, local governments, private
6 individuals, foundations and other agencies, and it may
7 M expend the monies received from such gifts and grants for
8 A the furtherance of the study objectives for which the
9 T committee is established. It shall adopt, by resolution
10 T of a majority of its full membership, any recommendations
11 E for submission to the office of the governor. It shall
12 R make annual reports to the governor.

13 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
14 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
