IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Governor's Advisory Committee on Fisheries; amending Sec. 7, Ch. 64, SLA 1959, and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 7, Ch. 64, SLA 1959, is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

N There is hereby established within the office of the
E governor an Advisory Committee on Fisheries Problems con-
W sisting of nine members, each appointed for a one year term.
Appointment of committee members shall be as follows: four
M members shall be appointed as representatives of the fishing
A industry, four members as representatives of Alaskan fish-
T ermen, and one member as a representative of the general
T public. The provisions of Sec. 6, Ch. 64, SLA 1959, apply
E to the committee except that members shall not be compensated
R for their services by payment of salary. The committee is
authorized to study fisheries problems, and in particular,
the establishment and growth in Alaska of a resident fishery
N E W The committee may publicize its purposes and objectives,
M A T T E R conduct surveys and studies, conduct public hearings, and
accept services of public and private agencies in gathering
information. The committee may accept gifts and grants from
the federal government, state government, local government

and private individuals, and it may expend the monies received from such gifts and grants for the furtherance of the study objectives for which the committee is established. The committee shall, prior to the convening of the 1963 Legislature, submit a report to the office of the governor, together with all recommendations which it feels pertinent.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
