6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Governor's Advisory
7 Committee on Fishery Economics; amending
8 Sec. 7, Ch. 64, SLA 1959; and providing for
9 an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 Section 1. Sec. 7, Ch. 64, SLA 1959, is amended by adding
12 a paragraph to read:

13 N There is hereby established within the office of the
14 E governor an Advisory Committee on Fisheries Economic Problems
15 W consisting of nine members, each appointed for a one year
16 M term. Appointment of committee members shall be as follows:
17 A four members shall be appointed as representatives of the
18 T fishing industry, four members as representatives of Alaskan
19 E fishermen, and one member as a representative of the general
20 R public. The provisions of Sec. 6, Ch. 64, SLA 1959, apply
21 to the committee except that members shall not be compensated
22 for their services by payment of salary. The committee is
23 authorized to study fisheries economic problems in an effort
24 to promote the establishment and growth in Alaska of a
25 resident fishery. The committee may publicize its purposes
26 and objectives, conduct economic surveys and studies, conduct
27 public hearings, and accept services of public and private
28 agencies in gathering information. The committee shall, prior
29 to the convening of the 1963 Legislature, submit a report to

1 the office of the governor, together with all recommendations
2 which it feels pertinent.

3 Sec. 2. This committee shall have no regulatory powers.

4 Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
5 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
