For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Governor's Advisory
7 Committee on Fishery Economics; amending
8 Sec. 7, Ch. 64, SLA 1959; and providing for
9 an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 7, Ch. 64, SLA 1959, is amended by adding

12

a paragraph to read:

13

There is hereby established within the office of the

14

governor an Advisory Committee on Fisheries Economic Problems

15

consisting of nine members, each appointed for a one year

16

term. Appointment of committee members shall be as follows:

17

four members shall be appointed as representatives of the

18

fishing industry, four members as representatives of Alaskan

19

fishermen, and one member as a representative of the general

20

public. Members of the committee shall be entitled to trans-

21

portation, per diem and compensation as prescribed in Sec.

22

1, Ch. 34, SLA 1960. The committee is authorized to study

23

fisheries economic problems in an effort to promote the

24

establishment and growth in Alaska of a resident fishery.

25

The committee may publicize its purposes and objectives, con-

26

duct economic surveys and studies, conduct public hearings,

27

and accept services of public and private agencies in gather-

28

ing information. The committee shall, prior to the convening

29

of the 1963 Legislature, submit a report to the office of

the governor, together with all recommendations which it
feels pertinent.

Sec. 2. This committee shall have no regulatory powers.

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
