6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating a committee to study and
7 plan for an Alaska Centennial celebration;
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE. The year 1967 will mark
11 the centennial anniversary of Alaska's purchase by the United
12 States and it is altogether fitting that that year be established
13 as a year of celebration. In recognition of the fact that a cele-
14 bration commensurate with Alaska's magnificent heritage will
15 require years of research, planning and preparation, the following
16 committee is established.

17 Sec. 2. CENTENNIAL COMMITTEE. There is hereby created, in
18 the Office of the Governor, an Alaska Centennial advisory committee.
19 The function of the committee will be that of making a study of
20 similar celebrations in other areas of the United States, with
21 the purpose of suggesting means by which the Alaska Centennial
22 should be financed and planned. The committee shall be composed
23 of 16 persons, appointed by the governor for a term of one year.
24 The committee shall make a report of its findings to the governor
25 prior to the convening of the 1963 legislature. Members shall not
26 be compensated for their services by payment of per diem, nor be
27 reimbursed for travel or other expenses.

28 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect on the day
29 after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law
