HOUSE BILL NO. 357

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to enforcement of contracts or bargaining agreements entered into by labor organizations; repealing Sec. 4, Ch. 108, SLA 1959; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. No court may enforce a contract or bargaining agreement between an employer and a labor organization unless

(1) the officers of the labor organization are residents of the state, elected by residents of the state; or

(2) the labor organization is acting at the direction of a local of that labor organization, the officers of which are residents of the state, elected by resident members of the local.

Sec. 2. "Labor organization" means an organization constituted in whole or in part to bargain collectively or deal with an employer on behalf of employees concerning grievances, terms or conditions of employment, or other mutual aid or protection.

Sec. 3. Sec. 4, Ch. 108, SLA 1959, is repealed.

Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
