HOUSE BILL NO. 358

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the designation of another officer to perform the authenticating functions of the Secretary of State in his absence; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. The Secretary of State may designate a head of a principal executive department, or more than one such officer in the alternative, who shall temporarily be custodian of the State Seal and perform the authenticating functions of the Secretary of State during such time as the Secretary of State shall succeed to the office of Governor, act as Governor, be absent from the State, or otherwise not be available at the state capitol to perform the above authenticating functions. The designation shall be in writing, signed by the Secretary of State, and filed in the office of the Secretary of State. The designation shall be effective until revoked by a later designation executed and filed in the same manner.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
