For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the payment of bounties
7 for the killing of hair seal, wolves, and
8 coyotes; and providing for an effective
9 date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 33-3-131, ACLA 1949, as last amended by Ch.

162, SLA 1960, is amended to read:

Sec. 33-3-131. BOUNTY ON HAIR SEAL DECLARED. There is

14

hereby placed on every hair seal inhabiting the inland waters

15

and all water adjacent to the [SOUTHERN] coast of Alaska

16

[EAST OF THE 152ND MERIDIAN, AND THE WATERS OF BRISTOL BAY

17

AND THE COASTAL WATERS WITHIN THREE MILES OFF THE MAINLAND

18

FROM CAPE NEUENHAM TO CAPE KRUZENSTERN, INCLUSIVE,] a bounty

19

of \$3.00, such sum to be paid in accordance with the pro-

20

visions following.

Sec. 2. Sec. 33-3-111, ACLA 1949, as amended by Ch. 18, SLA

1949, is amended to read:

Sec. 33-3-111. BOUNTY DECLARED: AMOUNT AND PAYMENT.

There is hereby placed upon every wild lobo or timber wolf

25

and every wild coyote or prairie wolf, legally taken within

26

the state [TERRITORY]; bounties of \$35.00 [FIFTY DOLLARS] on

27

wolves and \$20.00 [THIRTY DOLLARS] on coyotes, said sums to

28

be paid in accordance with provisions hereof.

29

Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage

1 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
