For an Act entitled: "An Act to prohibit the misuse, damage, or  
7 destruction of camps."

8

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9

Section 1. No person may misuse, damage, or destroy any  
10 camp not his own if there is evidence that the camp is in regular  
11 use or is being maintained for use.

Sec. 2. Any person who violates this Act is guilty of a  
13 misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not  
14 more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than three months,  
15 or by both.

Sec. 3. "Camp" means any improved site intended for habita-  
tion or use during any part of the year. It includes cabins,  
tents, tent frames or poles, drying racks, caches, supplies of  
food or fuel, building materials, furnishings of a tent or cabin,  
structures or things in and appurtenant to the site, or other  
improvements of the site.
