6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to prohibit the misuse, damage, or
7 destruction of camps; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 Section 1. No person shall misuse, damage, or destroy any
11 camp not his own if it is capable of use for protection of life
12 or property.

13 Sec. 2. "Camp" means any improved site intended for habita-
14 tion or use during any part of the year. It includes cabins,
15 tents, tent frames or poles, drying racks, caches, supplies of
16 food or fuel, building materials, furnishings of a tent or cabin,
17 structures or things in and appurtenant to the site, or other
18 improvements of the site.

19 Sec. 3. Any person who violates this Act is guilty of a
20 misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not
21 more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than three months,
22 or by both.

23 Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
24 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
