6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the qualifications of
7 the state director of personnel and the
8 personnel officers of the principal depart-
9 ments; providing for an applicable date;
10 and providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. QUALIFICATIONS. The head of the state division
13 of personnel of the Department of Administration and the princi-
14 pal personnel officer of any principal department of the state
15 responsible for the selection of personnel for employment by the
16 state shall have been residents of the state for at least five
17 years at the time of their appointment.

18 Sec. 2. APPLICABLE DATE. This Act is applicable effective
19 January 1, 1960.

20 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect on the day
21 after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law with-
22 out such approval.
