6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the re-employment of
7 veterans by the state and its political sub-
8 divisions; incorporating a portion of the
9 Universal Military Training and Service Act;
10 and providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 44-2-1, ACLA 1949, is amended to read:

13 Sec. 44-2-1. EXTENSION OF UNIVERSAL MILITARY TRAINING
14 AND [SELECTIVE] SERVICE ACT PROVISIONS TO ALASKA [TERRI-
15 TORIAL] EMPLOYEES. Section 9(b)(B) [8] of the Universal

16 Military [SELECTIVE] Training and Service Act [OF 1940], as
17 amended, 50 USC sec. 459(b)(B) [(50 USC APP SEC. 308)], is
18 hereby extended to the State [TERRITORY] of Alaska and its
19 political subdivisions, it being the intent of this Act that
20 all re-employment benefits granted by Section 9(b)(B) [8]
21 of the Universal Military [SELECTIVE] Training and Service
22 Act [OF 1940 (50 USC APP SEC. 308)] to any veteran who was
23 in the employ of a private employer at the time of his in-
24 duction into the armed forces of the United States shall,
25 in the same manner and to the same extent, be granted to any
26 veteran who was in the employ of the State [TERRITORY] of
27 Alaska or any political subdivision thereof at the time of
28 his induction into the armed forces of the United States.

29 As used in this section "veteran" means any person subject

to the Universal Military Training and Service Act.
