6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the re-employment of  
7 veterans by the state and its political sub-  
8 divisions; incorporating a portion of the  
9 Universal Military Training and Service Act;  
10 and providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 Section 1. Sec. 44-2-1, ACLA 1949, is amended to read:

13 Sec. 44-2-1. EXTENSION OF UNIVERSAL MILITARY TRAINING  
14 AND [SELECTIVE] SERVICE ACT PROVISIONS TO ALASKA [TERRI-  
15 TORIAL] EMPLOYEES. Section 9 [8] of the Universal Military  
16 [SELECTIVE] Training and Service Act [OF 1940], as amended,  
17 50 USC sec. 459 [ (50 USC APP SEC. 308) ], is hereby extended  
18 to the State [TERRITORY] of Alaska and its political subdivi-  
19 sions, it being the intent of this Act that all re-employment  
20 benefits granted by Section 9 [8] of the Universal Military  
21 [SELECTIVE] Training and Service Act [OF 1940 (50 USC APP SEC.  
22 308)] to any veteran who was in the employ of a private em-  
23 ployer at the time of his induction into the armed forces of  
24 the United States shall, in the same manner and to the same  
25 extent, be granted to any veteran who was in the employ of the  
26 State [TERRITORY] of Alaska or any political subdivision  
27 thereof at the time of his induction into the armed forces  
28 of the United States. As used in this section "veteran" means  
29 any person subject to the Universal Military Training and

Service Act.

Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
