SECOND LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the salaries of
teachers, and other employees of the public
schools."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Section 1. Sec. 37-6-1, ACLA 1949, as last amended by Sec.
1, Ch. 51, SLA 1961, is repealed and re-enacted to read:

Sec. 37-6-1. TEACHERS' SALARY SCALE BY SENATE DISTRICT.

(a) The school boards of school districts in the State of
Alaska, and the state Department of Education as the operat-
ing agency for schools outside school districts, shall pay
regularly qualified teachers employed by them a salary of
not less than that set out in the following scale:

(1) SOUTHEASTERN SENATE DISTRICT

6 (2) SOUTHCENTRAL SENATE DISTRICT. In the South-
7 central Senate District, the amount of \$400.00 shall be
8 added to each step of the Southeastern Senate District
9 salary scale.

10 (3) CENTRAL AND NORTHWEST SENATE DISTRICTS AND
11 THAT PART OF THE SOUTHCENTRAL SENATE DISTRICT LYING WEST OF
12 152° WEST LONGITUDE. In the Central and Northwest Senate
13 Districts and in that part of the Southcentral Senate Dist-
14 rict lying West of 152° West Longitude, the amount of
15 \$700.00 shall be added to each step of the Southeastern
16 Senate District salary scale.

17 (b) Not more than four years public school experience
18 outside Alaska may be substituted for a like period of
19 public school experience in Alaska when a teacher's position
20 on the salary scale is established.

21 Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1962.
